

Bledlow Coffee-time Concert

We are thrilled to be welcoming back the internationally acclaimed pianist Peng Lin, who appeared at Bledlow last December as accompanist and will now give a solo recital on Saturday 25th May.

Peng Lin is the first prize winner of the 2023 Massarosa International Piano Competition. She made her New York Lincoln Center debut in 2015 with the Juilliard Orchestra conducted by Peter Oundjian. She was a laureate of renowned competitions, including Rhodes International Piano Competition, Rina Sala Gallo International Piano Competition, Lyon International Piano Competition, Antwerp International Piano Competition and UK Open Piano International Piano Competition. She has performed on the stages of Alice Tully Hall, Carnegie Weill Hall, Muziekgebouw and Shanghai Concert Hall. She has appeared in Aspen Music Festival, Chigiana International Music Festival, Oxford Piano Festival, Sarasota Music Festival and Taos Chamber Music Festival.

Born in Kulangsu (Gulangyu), the 'piano island' of China, Peng Lin made her orchestral debut with Mozart Concerto K 467 at the age of 9. She received a full scholarship to attend the Juilliard School at the age of 16. She subsequently received her Bachelor of Music and Master of Music degrees from the Juilliard School, a Master of Musical Arts from Yale School of Music and an Artist Diploma from the Royal College of Music in London. She worked closely with Dmitri Alexeev, Yoheved Kaplinsky, Hung-Kuan Chen, Ian Jones and Peter Serkin. She is currently under the tutelage of Benedetto Lupo at the Accademia Nazionale di Santa Cecilia in Rome.
