As a freelance orchestral harpist she has worked with ensembles across the UK, performing under distinguished conductors, including Marin Alsop, Semyon Bychkov and Bernard Haitink.

A frequent recording artist, Imogen has recorded at Abbey Road Studios and appears on albums by Grammy Award-winning artist Imogen Heap. Equally at home in contemporary, jazz and classical repertoire, she brings elegance, colour and expressive depth to every performance. Alongside her performing career, she is a dedicated teacher and mentor at the Royal College of Music Junior Department.
